The meeting was called to order at 5pm by Kathy Houston.

Introduction of Andrew Gale, returning member of the committee.

Motion by Rob seconded by Stacey to approved the minutes. Approved.

Discussion of placing a sign which would direct people of the water falls. Brent mentioned the existing signs are weathering more than usual. Two signs including a map & waterfall sign to placed where needed. Motion by Stacey, seconded by Brent, motion passed.

A hiking challenge discussion was lead by Brent. Highlighted that trails were brushed and painted by those attempting to make their own loop through Shiloh and others' private property. Brent said he had made it clear to them that their activities were not in the best interest of the property. The select board will be advised of what took place.

Rob made a presentation on the condition of Shiloh Pond and Tufts Pond road. Handouts were provided which summarized the on-site review by Dan Simonds, a forester with Mixed Wood in Rangeley. He found the access conditions acceptable , but likely to deteriorate. The summary highlights an urgent need at the end of town road, where the ditches are eroding and overwhelming the drainage structure. Majority of the work needed will require ditching, new gravel and crowning the road. It was suggested this work be a 3-year project.
