Article 2. To see if the town will release, discharge and abandon all of rights, title and interest to a Sewer Easement located at 368 Main Street, known as Town Tax Map 18, Lot 17 and recorded in the Franklin County Registry of Deeds Book 748, Page 42 to S and B - Kingfield, LLC?

The Registrar of Voters will be available every weekday from 8:30 AM to 4:30 PM in the Town Office and on Town Meeting Day from 8:45 AM until the end of Town Meeting to accept the Registration of any person eligible to vote in Town affairs. A person who is not a registered voter may not vote in any election.
