Chairman Lander calls the meeting to order.

The board reviews the minutes from December 1, 2025. Motion to accept by Selectman Browne. Seconded by Selectman Jordan. 3 in favor, 2 abstain.

The board reviews the minutes from January 5, 2026. Motion to accept by Selectman Rushton. Seconded by Selectman Dunham. 3 in favor, 2 abstain.

Old Business:

The board discusses the gift of land from the late David Holmes. The board agrees that this is a wonderful gift and there is discussion on future plans. Update on West Kingfield Road culvert known as the Lander Bridge. There is an estimate from Vortex Services for \$248, 550.00. There is discussion about how this is about half of what the box culvert solution would cost. Questions from the public include finding grant funds, etc.

Sue Davis to challenge wastewater billing. Sue is unhappy with how she is billed for a 4 bedroom house and doesn't use that much water. The board explains that everyone needs to be billed the same way, regardless of how many people live there. She will contact the state.

Selectmen Discussion: Selectman Browne says the New Years celebration at the SnoWanderers went well and it was fun. Lots of great prizes and fireworks.
